Day 1 - Edmonton to Moose Jaw

Welcome aboard your deluxe coach as your tour begins in Edmonton. Travel east through Lloydminster (coffee), North Battleford & Saskatoon (lunch) then south to Moose Jaw. Get settled into your room before trying your luck at the casino. (\$30.00 casino package is included) **Hotel – Temple Gardens or Heritage Inn**

Day 2 – Moose Jaw to Deadwood, South Dakota

This morning, you'll board the coach traveling south to Weyburn (coffee) then continue south to the U.S. where you'll cross into the state of North Dakota at the Port of Fortuna. After a lunch stop in Williston and coffee in Belfield, you continue your travel south to your destination for the next 3 nights, Deadwood, S.D. Enjoy your free evening. **Hotel – Mineral Palace**

Day 3 – Mount Rushmore & Crazy Horse Monument Tour

This morning after your complimentary breakfast, enjoy a side trip through the Black Hills to Mount Rushmore and the Crazy Horse Monument. You'll have time to take pictures and have lunch before boarding your coach back to Deadwood. A minimum 20 people are required for this optional tour. The cost is \$10.00 U.S. per person.

Day 4 – Deadwood Activities

After your complimentary breakfast, you may want to explore this Historic town with its many gaming halls (89), restaurants (36) and museums.

Day 5 – Deadwood to Moose Jaw

Today you'll begin your trek homeward, stopping for coffee in Belfield, N.D., lunch in Williston and a duty free stop at the border before arriving back in Canada. From there it's on to Moose Jaw your stop for tonight. You'll be transported to the Casino for a date with lady Luck (\$60.00 casino package included). **Hotel – Temple Gardens or Heritage Inn**

Day 6 – Moose Jaw to Edmonton

Tour Rates

Tour rates are applicable at the time of printing and are based on current costs, current hotels and exchange rates. The company, Promotion Tours reserves the right to alter the published price if needed without notice. Casinos also have the right to change value packages without notice.

Deposits & Payments

A \$100.00 deposit per person will reserve your seat. Final payment is due 6 weeks prior to the departure date (unless otherwise specified). To qualify for special pricing where a discount is shown, you must book and pay on or before the date specified.

Cancellation

You may cancel your trip without penalty provided Promotion Tours or its agents receive written notification no later than (30) days prior to departure. We do recommend cancellation insurance.

Itineraries

Promotion Tours reserves the right to make itinerary changes at any time, for any reason as deemed prudent by the Company for the welfare of it's passengers or to enhance the operation of the tour. We'll make every effort to inform passengers of changes, but Promotion Tours will not be responsible for ensuring that such information is communicated to the passengers. Travel Insurance

Documentation

When crossing international borders, proper identification is required. Canadian citizens need a birth certificate and valid picture identification or a passport. Non-Canadians should contact their local immigration department for details of requirements. This proof of citizenship is your responsibility.

Seating

All seating is on a first-come first-served basis. For trips lasting more than one day to get to a final destination, a seat rotation will be utilized affording all passengers different seating positions.

Smoking

For your convenience and comfort, No SMOKING IS ALLOWED ABOARD THE MOTOR COACH. Coffee and meal stops will be done every 2 to 3 hours, which will give passengers the opportunity to smoke.

Miscellaneous Information

Bring your prescriptions (medications) with you and ensure you have your Alberta Health Card. Any serious medical conditions must be brought to the attention of your tour guide prior to boarding. This is a preventative safety measure in case of a medical emergency.

Please be on time as we want to arrive at our destinations at a reasonable time. Scheduled stops will have time limits to ensure we reach our destination on time.

One suitcase per person and a carry-on is allowed. If you plan to golf, we'll transport your clubs as well.

For passenger convenience, bottled water will be available for a nominal charge of 25 cents per bottle. You may bring your own beverages onboard if you so desire.

Your driver and tour director try very hard to make your trip informative, entertaining and enjoyable and will do everything possible to ensure that you have a safe and comfortable journey. If you feel the service you have received meets or exceeds your expectations, gratuities are greatly appreciated.
